### Help improve literacy

United Way of North Central Florida is recruiting senior citizens, age 55 and older, to read with elementary school children and mentor ninth-grade high school students.

The Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) is a three-year national grant through the Corporation for National and Community Service.

Seniors serve in one of three United Way of North Central Florida education initiatives focused on increasing high school graduation rates:

**EARLY READING PROGRAM:** Read with a pre-Kindergarten student for a minimum of 30 minutes per week.

**READING PALS:** Read with a second- or third-grade student for a minimum of one hour per week.

**CHECK & CONNECT:** Mentor a ninth-grade high school student for one hour per week.
